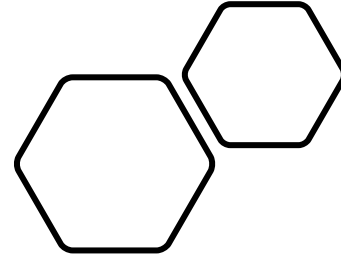


# Participation Lab #3

1. Visit the following site:

Read the article related to the use of the modifier, “only”. Summarize what you learned in your own words – **do not** use direct quotes.
