If this is may answer to these questions....		Then I would conclude the questions in my evaluation focus are/are not reasonable ones to ask right now.
1	How long has the intervention been underway?	In order to assess the intervention accurately, one must know its temporal direction. It also will clarify if any changes have been made or if there are difficulties with the implementation process over time. Since 2011 it has been underway
2	How intensive/ambitious is the intervention? Multifaceted effort or simple intervention?	This is a reasonable question at this stage as well. An intervention's intensity and ambition have a highly pronounced effect on its respective level. Evaluation of the intervention outcomes and whether or not it was realistic in achieving its desired results will be determined by understanding how complex the intervention is.
3	How much (time and money) can be devoted to evaluation of this effort?	It needs to be considered in the evaluation planning even though it remains impactful regarding methodology and breadth range. Only after a better definition of this intervention and its dealing with effectiveness can we construct a more realistic timeline for implementation and budget.
