

Worksheet 3A Focusing the Evaluation in the Logic Model

If this is the situation...		Then these are the parts of the logic model I would include in my evaluation focus:
1	Who is asking evaluation question of the program?	The stakeholders responsible for asking the evaluation questions must bear in mind engaging either government affiliates or program staff along with community leaders. Such stakeholders have a vested interest in noting how the effectiveness and influence of this program addressed health disparity issues and impacts on community health.
2	Who will use the evaluation results and for what purpose?	The evaluation outcomes will be employed by all stakeholders as well as other members of the community for program monitoring and enhancement aimed at reducing health disparities. Program stakeholders can utilize the outcomes to make rational resource allocation decisions and design a program. Society can also rely on the outcomes to ensure that it is being rectified and addressed.
3	In Step I, did we identify interests of other stakeholders that we must take into account?	From Step I, other stakeholders who need to be considered include individuals and organizations representing communities at the margin, hard hit by health inequities in Chicago. These stakeholders are interested in ensuring their communities get the resources and support they need to improve health outcomes. Their contributions and views determine how the program works and contribute to deciding if it is effective.
