POLICY DEVELOPMENT PROJECT

A. PURPOSE OF THE POLICY DEVELOPMENT PROJECT:

- Intended to provide the student with a concentrated perspective on a defined issue that identifies the link between the environment and human health.
- The research should explain the issues, define the challenges, identify current policy, and propose or mend the current policy

B. POLICY DEVELOPMENT PROJECT:

- The POLICY DEVELOPMENT PROJECT is an extension of your selected topic and your power point presentation.
- The student can select to develop a new policy approach or amend a current policy
- The paper will focus on the analysis of existing environmental health policies based on the topic selected.
- The students will CREATE AND PRESENT THEIR POLICY RECOMMENDATION as a Power Point presentation.
- The ORAL PRESENTATION should be 5-8 minutes and must introduce a new or updated policy recommendation
- Students are expected to coordinate with other students that select the same topic so that different material is covered.
- Students will review a minimum of six (6) articles for the completion of the research paper.
- Guidance for writing a policy paper will be posted in CANVAS
- **Student may select to do a two (2) person team project with prior approval from the Professor.**
- **STUDENTS WILL PRESENT THEIR POWER POINT IN CLASS DURING FINALS WEEK - THIS IS THE FINAL EXAM.**

C. PROJECT GRADING CRITERIA

1. How well did the student understand the issue
2. How well was the topic researched - were the six sources met?
3. Was the information collected correct?
4. Did the student develop a new policy or amend a current policy?
5. Did the student submit a pre-presentation outline for policy development?
6. Did the student follow the guidelines for development of the power point presentation?
7. Were grammar, punctuation and word usage correct?
8. Was the presentation a cause for action?
