### **Scenario 1**

**You really love one of your classes and enjoy reading the course material, but you often receive a low grade on written assignments due to poor grammar, spelling and sentence structure. You notice an ad online for a professional writing service that guarantees you higher marks. Will you violate the academic integrity policy if you use this service?**

Please respond to the following questions:

- 1) Have you violated the Academic Integrity policy? Explain your reasoning.
- 2) Is there an alternate option? How else could you improve your grades on written assignments?

### **Scenario 2**

**You are enrolled in a course where the Professor requires students to sign-in weekly, as they enter the classroom. A classmate is unable to attend this week and asks you to sign in for him. You believe the reason for the absence is valid and the Professor has yet to verbalize that they are assessing Professional Conduct, so you go ahead and do so.**

Please respond to the following questions:

### **Scenario 3**
