So, the Participants subsection requires that we have data from the survey, but it's still open [until tomorrow](#). Thus, I will not have the demographic information (age range, sex and gender distribution, etc.) [until Saturday](#).

Should you wish to take advantage of the early submission bonus (a bonus 5% if submitted by [Friday night](#)) you may use placeholders. You will have to remember to replace the placeholders with the correct numbers in the final submission or some points will be deducted from that final submission, but it should not be hard to remember to do that. Write it up something like this:

"Participants in this study consisted of a total of XX people whose average age was XX ($SD = XX$) with a range from 18 years old to XX years old. Of these, XX were self-identified women, XX were self-identified men, and XX were self-identified non-binary individuals. XX indicated that they were born females, XX indicated that they were born male, and XX that they were born something other than male or female. XX

born something other than male or female. XX participants were Black, XX were Asian..."

Keep in mind that you WILL report the following:

- age (mean, standard deviation, and range);
- the sex-assigned-at-birth distribution of the participants (the number of males, females, and other)
- the gender identity distribution of the participants (the number of women, men, and non-binary)
- the racial/ethnic distribution of the participants

No, you're not using all of these as variables, but the descriptive data on these will be reported nonetheless.
