

### III. Cultural inquiry-level II-template

Take your cultural paper and do the following, each letter A, B, C...should be a paragraph, double-spaced.

- A. What are the cultures being examined in this paper and why?
- B. Is one more susceptible to something, is one more isolated, is one unable to seek treatment, etc. Be specific and use other sources to cite the reasons why (this might be monetary, based on location, cultural diets, access, find all of these aspects state how they are related to your topic and cite.
- C. Find a study that examines one or more of these issues you've discovered "A study done by (Author, year) examines the cultural issues of \_\_\_\_\_ pertaining to the topic of \_\_\_\_\_ because \_\_\_\_\_ (cite).
- D. State why the author(s) have chosen this issue. "This study was done because it was shown that \_\_\_\_\_.
- E. State at least three key points and use ONE quote to show how they support the cultural arguments. Remember to try and keep quotes at minimum and reword and EXPLAIN any terms that a patient may not understand. Pretend your patient is ten years old.
- F. Find and quote from a DIFFERENT scientific source that agrees OR disagrees with these findings.
- E. Are there other issues that are neglected in this paper? Can you find research supporting those?
- F. Find a short quote from one or two of these OTHER sources that find OTHER issues not stated in your main article.

NOTE: Each part of answering this template should be one paragraph with AT LEAST one citation.

Sometimes finding cultural aspects of topics do not come naturally, and a quick google search with the key points of your topic and just the words "cultural aspects" and "scholarly articles" can get you started.
