### What Accreditation is



### Steps of the Accreditation Process

1. Meeting the CBAHI accreditation standards as a facility (Alkhenizan & Shaw, 2010).
2. Conducting a Self Check on the Compliance.
3. Applying for Survey by CBAHI officials (Survey).
4. Acting on the Recommendations by Management.
5. Re-applying for Assessment (Survey).
6. Being Accredited.
