- 1) Three (3) Major contributions Florence Nightingale made for nursing practice. Please give examples and explanations.
- 2) Describe Evidence-Based Practice as it applies to Nursing
- 3) Why is Nursing a Profession?
- 4) Explain and give examples of Dorothea Orem's self-care deficit Theory as it relates to patient care delivery and its significance in nursing practice.
- 5) Present Patricia Benner's Theory as it relates to the role of the student towards license practice from Novice to Expert
- 6) Explain Advanced Directives and its importance and relevance in health care. Identify nursing responsibilities related to Advanced Directives.
- 7) Explain a DNR, DNT and DNI and what to expect in providing care, appropriate documentation and legal ramification, give examples.
- 8) Compare and contrast Assault, Battery, Negligence and Malpractice. Give examples and identify nursing responsibility as an advocate. Identify potential victims/perpetrators
- 9) Explain the role of the Ethics Committee in Acute Care or Long term Care. Identify who makes up the Team in Ethics Committee, their roles and how they reach their decisions.

Guidelines for Poster Assignment

Size no Smaller than 22" x 28" Poster Board

Type of material: Durable, firm and white colored poster board. Posters may be custom printed at Staples or Office Depot.

Presentation:

1. Main heading should be large enough to be read from a distance of 2 feet.
2. Keep type set simple and clear so that the information is easily understood.
3. Pictures and diagrams may be used.
4. Exercise individual creativity.
5. Short, simple and concise
6. Remember that the Poster assignment is expected to emphasize the importance of nursing, either in role, education, practice and/or evolution.
7. Information must be accurate and reliable. Easy to be understood by anyone.
8. Please submit work ON TIME. Please make sure that your name is written on the bottom right hand corner of the poster or below the poster title.
9. Write the Reference List on a separate sheet or you may write as a part of the poster. Reference List are written at the last section of the poster.
