

Rubric - The Method section

I recommend including a title page to practice getting formatting right. Similarly, practice having a running head and page numbering properly located in the upper left and right corners of each page.

If you wish to append this to the *Introduction* section submitted previously, you may do that. However, only the *Method* and its references will be evaluated for the Week 7 assignment.

Use the same font you selected for the *Introduction* section.

A properly formatted *References* page is required.

Students are expected to use feedback from their *Introduction* section to improve the formatting and other elements of this and subsequent assignments.
