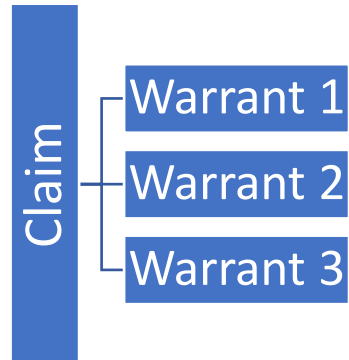
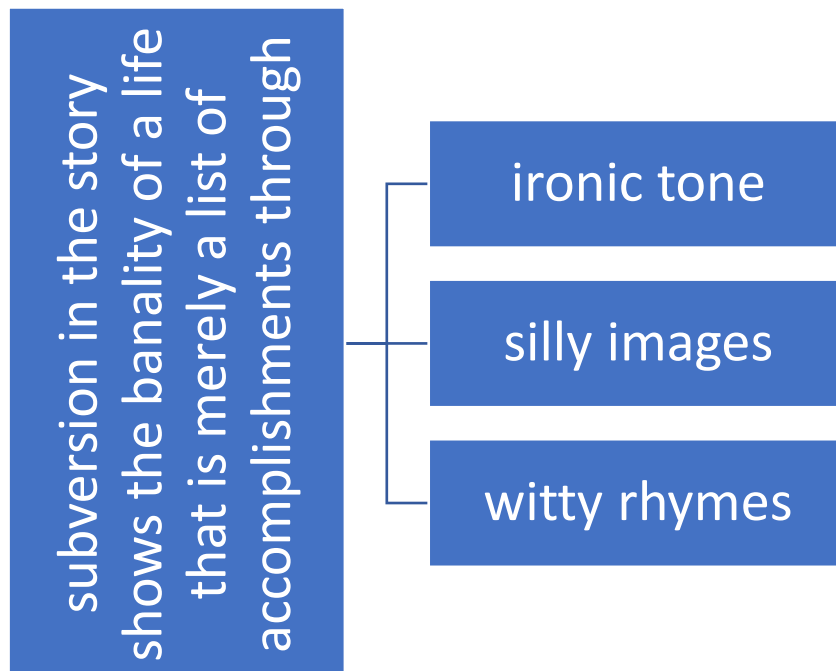


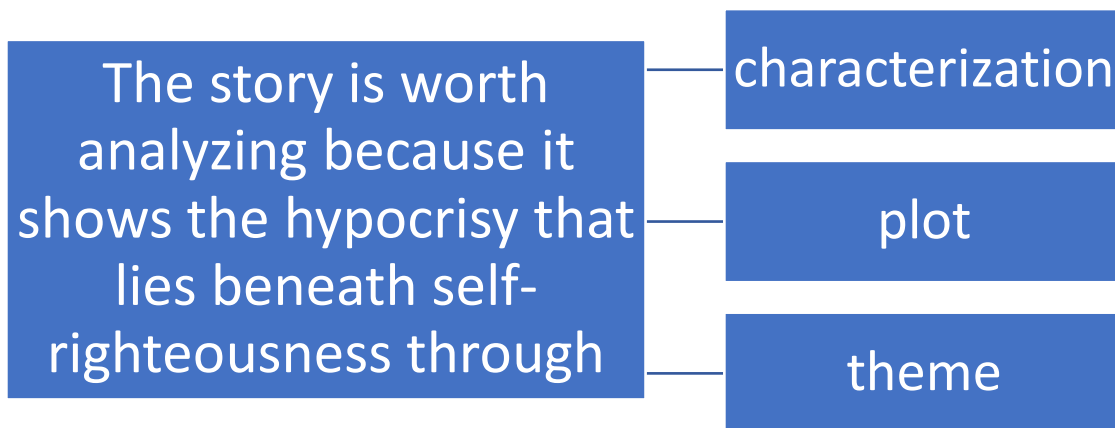
THESIS BLUEPRINT



In "Résumé," Dorothy Parker subverts the idea of what a résumé is-- accomplishments and experiences--with an ironic tone, silly images of suicide, and witty rhymes to point out the banality of life for those who remain too disengaged from it.



Flannery O'Connor's "A Good Man is Hard to Find" is an excellent example of a literary work because it demonstrates the hypocrisy of the Grandmother's religious and moral position through its approach to characterization, plot, and theme.
