Topic: Other countries' Dream vs. the American Dream

Research Question(s): Do other countries and cultures have their own national Dream in any way similar to the "American Dream?"

Working Thesis [**expressed as an argument claim and answer to the research question(s)**]: Some other countries and cultures have their own national Dream but more commonly, versions of the American Dream can be found around the world.

Discussion: [**150 words minimum**] My preliminary research has found that some other nations and cultures have national Dreams, some of them unique to that country or culture, but I have also found that the American Dream or aspects of it can be found in many parts of the world. In fact, some sources claim the American Dream is no longer unique to the American experience and is more commonly attainable in some other countries than the USA. Examples of the sources I have found that may be incorporated into my research paper have titles like 1) "Want the American Dream? Move to These Countries Instead...", 2) "Other countries' Dreams (America is Exceptional. So Are Other Countries)", 3) "The Not-American Dream: Do other countries have national catchphrases?", 4) "How the World Perceives the New American Dream (And why today's dream doesn't export as well as the original)", and 5) "The American Dream Is Alive and Well, Just Not So Much in America."
