

HPI: Baby Nicolas is an 8-month-old White male brought in by his mother due to an on and off cheek redness. The mother, the baby has a good appetite but she noticed that the baby's cheeks start getting red when he is fed less breast milk, more formula. He defecates regularly and has 6 to 8 wet diapers in a 24-hour period.

Past Medical Family History: Unremarkable

Allergies: NKA

Current Meds: none.

Review of system

Constitutional: Mother claims good appetite; denies chills; denies fatigue or fever; no unexpected weight change

HEENT: Mother denies dental problem, mouth sores, nosebleed or runny nose, eye discharge/itching/eye pain/eye redness

Cardiovascular: Mother denies chest pain, chest discomfort or shortness of breath

Respiratory: Mother denies choking, cough, shortness of breath or wheezing

Gastrointestinal: Mother denies abdominal pain, anal bleeding, blood in stool, constipation, diarrhea, nausea/vomiting

Skin /Integumentary: Mother claims pruritus (+) rashes on bilateral cheeks

Physical examination

Age: 8 months

Weight: 23.3 lbs; Height: 34.2 cm; Head circumference: 33.5 cm

Temperature: 98.0F; Heart rate: 126 bpm; Respiratory rate: 30 bpm

General: no acute distress, well-hydrated, playful, cooperative/pleasant

Head: normocephalic, normal hair distribution, anterior fontanel open

Lungs: [-] scattered rhonchi, [-] rales, [-] wheezing present

Heart: regular rhythm; normal rate; palpable pulses (radial, DP, PT)

Skin: red rash with dry/peeling skin on cheeks bilaterally, no discharge noted
